Welcome to the April edition of my e-Focus in which I update local residents on news items, council meetings and planning applications in the Alamein ward.

The last month has seen several good news items for Alamein ward as a result of work over the past years.

In Smannell the project to bring quality broadband to the village is nearing completion. I am pleased to have been a part of the project team from the beginning and congratulate the team for their success. What a pity that politicians with no input or interest in the project have now tried to high jack it for their own ends.

We also had another successful meeting of the Roman Way forum attended by the police and local residents. I am pleased to report that many of the highways issues raised several times in the past and discussed at the February meeting are finally being dealt with. A number of other complaints were raised and your town councillors and I will be following up on these.

After six years of campaigning we can finally see work on improvements to the Enham arch roundabout. Work will start in in May on traffic calming and repairs to Viking Way. After this Icknield Way will be closed to through traffic as agreed after my residents survey last year.

The Alamein community association of which I am a trustee, is, in partnership with the Turnaround project, close to completing an application for lottery funding of £500,000 to be spent in Alamein ward over the next five years .We would like your help in deciding where that money should be spent. Many of you will have already had questionnaires if not you can complete the survey at one of the following online addresses or contact me and I'll send you a paper copy.
