## **ENHAM "SIGNS" CLEAN—UP**



Enham Lib Dems Focus group have been busy over the New Year cleaning, reporting dirty and damaged street signs. Local campaigner Nigel Gooding pictured alongside the CANGO bus sign in Enham spotted that a number of signs that were either in a state of disrepair or filthy. Enham Lib Dems cleaned some of the reachable signs and reported rest. The FOCUS group now have assurances from Hampshire and Test Valley Council to clean up the signs and ensure a system going forward to prevent a reoccurrence.

The responsibility for maintaining and cleaning the signs lies with Tory led Hampshire and Test Valley Councils. It is a complicated arrangement which judging by the state of the signs does not work effectively or give value for money. Nigel took up the challenge and started cleaning the signs himself and those out of reach reported to Hampshire and Test Valley Councils.

Nigel said " We cleaned the signs where we could and the rest have been reported to Hampshire and Test Valley Councils. Senior Managers have given me a pledge that they will be cleaned over the next few weeks and repairs carried out. They will also put in a system to ensure that we do not see the signs get into this state again"


