December is a quiet month for local councils but there is still a lot going on in the background and January will be a busy month for meetings and other work.

Discussions are continuing on details of the new parish council for Andover and existing borough councillors are being consulted about the parish's first budget. The new council has already caught the imagination of residents, several of whom have contacted me about becoming a parish councillor. If you, or anyone else, is interested who is let me know.

Meanwhile the debate over the future of the Guildhall has re-opened because Prezzo still has not signed a lease. The time has come for them to make up their mind and if their answer is no then we must look at ALL alternative options for the building. I will be raising this with council leader lan Carr before and at January's council meeting.


At the same meeting I will be proposing a motion calling for Twinings to reconsider their proposed redundancy program. I fully support the Twinings union's attempts to retain and expand production in Andover and hope my fellow councillors and our local MP's will do the same.

Also on the agenda is a Lib Dem motion on local bus services. This will not be debated at the council meeting, but bus services will be discussed at the Andover Forum later in the month. The Forum has been postponed from 18th to 25th January to allow for this. Two day's later Manuela Wahnon will be speaking to the council's scrutiny committee about her "Attitude of Gratitude" campaign. I wish her well with the presentation, and with her Campaign, which I fully support.

Finally the long awaited plans for the redevelopment of Enham have now been submitted (see overleaf). As a member of the planning committee I can't comment on them but I would urge all interested residents to look at them. If you have any queries or concerns please raise them with the planning department, or your local parish, or borough, councillors.
