Welcome to the March edition of my e-Focus in which I update local residents on news items, council meetings and planning applications in the Alamein ward.

February's council meeting approved the council tax levels for the year 2010/2011. This includes a 2.5% increase in Test Valley's tax, a similar rise in the Andover levy and increases from Hampshire County Council, the police and fire services. Andover residents will also pay a precept for the new town council. Charges for a band D property are expected to be £1402.03 in Andover, £1391.92 in Enham and £1385.38 in Smannell. Full details will be sent to all households over the next month.

Also this month councillors considered and approved revised plans for the lower Guildhall. A new restaurant group (Zippers) wants to move in as soon as possible. I believe the original decision to let the building to a restaurant was wrong. But, given the delay in letting the building, the urgent need to refurbish it, and to prevent further loss of council tax payers money it is not in the public interest to oppose this decision.

Changes in local bus services are being investigated by the council's scrutiny committee. If anyone has any particular points they want raised please let me know. The committee plans to report back to full council in April.

I have asked again for urgent actions to resolve flooding on Smannell Road open space and, following complains about speeding and contractor traffic I have asked for an update on the installation of traffic calming on Icknield Way.


I am also liasing with police and community safety managers to improve policing on Roman Way and to that end joined officers on patrol in the area last Friday night.

Tenders are being sought to improve broad band provision to Smannell and Little London and it is hoped a contractor for the project will be appointed in early April.

Finally the campaign against fluoridation of Hampshire's water supply continues with an open letter to the Strategic Health Authority calling on them to reconsider their decision to add fluoride to Southampton's water. I was pleased to be a signatory to that letter.
