First story for July must be that, after a long campaign by many people, Andover now has its own town council. Regular readers will know I have supported this for many years and I'm pleased to see it now place. I'm especially pleased to see twelve of the nineteen members are not existing councillors but people new to the job who will broaden representation and accountability across the town. I look forward to working with them, especially with the new councillors for Alamein ward Barbara Carpenter and Kevin Hughes.

The Askalot shop has been given permission to continue for a further three years with extended opening hours allowing it to provide a better service local residents. I look forward to it's continuing success and closer links between it and the Alamein Community Association.

On 20th July a three day public enquiry opens into the proposed re-routing of Smannell Road. I have submitted and objection to this proposal and will be backing the parish council's call to keep the existing road open.

Another Trajan Walk/Hadrian Road residents meeting took place on 12th June. I am pleased to report that, thanks to police action, incidents of anti-social behaviour have reduced and there has been progress on a number of other issues. The next meeting will be on 4th September.

The long awaited report on local buses will be submitted to the council's scrutiny committee early next week and will include calls for improvements to existing services and further work to find funding for Sunday services.

I have recently finished a survey of traffic on Icknield Way and submitted it to the planning and highways authorities asking for a review of existing traffic calming and future plans for the road. The existing traffic calming is unacceptable, I look forward to their response.
