Welcome to the October edition of my e-Focus in which I update local residents on news items, council meetings and planning applications in the Alamein ward. The campaign to retain all the discretionary elements of Test Valley's concessionary fare package continues. The matter was discussed at last month's council meeting when councillors voted unanimously in support of my motion calling on the county council to continue to provide the same level of service as currently provided. The deadline for the county's consultation has been extended until 8 October. Councillors also voted to continue to support community car schemes like Neighbourcare.

At the same meeting the council also supported plans to outlaw wheel clamping on private property. Unfortunately they decided not to back a call for meetings to be held at 5:30 instead of 4:00 so as to allow more members of the public to attend.

There is still no news on the re-routing of Smannell Road or on resolving traffic issues in Icknield Way. I have chased highways officers for an answer on this and am speaking to them about a number of other issues relating to highway repairs, parking and overgrown trees around Alamein ward.

Another successful meeting of Roman Way residents too place on 4 September where the police, town councillors and housing officers were available to answer questions from, and deal with issues raised by, local residents. These meetings will now become regular Roman Way Forums every two months. Future meetings are scheduled for November, when Neighbourhood wardens have been invited to attend, and again in January. More details on this next month.

On 21st October there is a by-election for a county councillor in Andover South and I have been asked and agreed to stand as candidate. This to me is a logical progression to the work I am already doing working with county officers on a number of issues in Alamein ward and around the town. I will continue to sit on Test Valley Borough Council to represent you and if elected I look forward to representing all of Andover on both Test Valley and Hampshire county councils as does Alamein and Andover North's current county councillor.
