Welcome to the November edition of my e-Focus in which I update local residents on news items, council meetings and planning applications in the Alamein ward. The fight to retain all the discretionary elements of Test Valley's concessionary fare package continues. I have received dozens of responses from residents backing the campaign. I will be passing all the comments on to county councillors who will make the final decision.

Highways planners and developers have responded favourably to my request for action on traffic in Icknield Way. Work will start next year on proposals to close the road to through traffic north of the junction with Viking Way.

Overgrown trees have been removed from the rear of houses on Tintagel Close and I am currently working with council officers to deal with a number of other problem trees.

I have also been chasing the developers and planning department for news on the long awaited community centre in Augusta Park. The opening was delayed because the building failed to meet DDA (disabled access) requirements. Test Valley officers are negotiating with the developers to get them to bring the building up to specification. Residents of Augusta Park will be able to vote in the community centre for future elections. If the building is not ready or unavailable their polling station will be at Smannell Road Church centre.

As mentioned last month, following the success of residents meetings over the summer, regular Roman Way Forums will be held at the church centre in Smannell Road. These will give local residents the opportunity to raise any issues of local concern to councillors, police and council or housing officers. The next meeting is on Saturday 6th November at 3:00pm.

Work is now underway to close the lower High Street to traffic making the area safer for pedestrians and shoppers. This has meant the removal of disabled parking from in front of the Guildhall but addition spaces have been provided in several other places around the town centre. Also planned is a disabled passenger drop off point by the Time Ring and a community bus stop in Waterloo Court with improvements to the footpath from the Globe to Waterloo Court to give better access to the High Street. Extra seating has also been installed.

Let me know what you think of proposals to plant a tree in the High Street. I would also like to hear your views on the campaign to move the Cenotaph back to the High Street.
